# Future Anxiety and Young People's Political Attitudes

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## I. Background

Times of multiple crises

Young people anxious about the future Theory & Narrative -> Right-wing ideology

RQ: How is future anxiety related to young people's political attitudes?

# II. Method

Online survey of 16-21-year-olds

•  $N \approx 988$  from  $\rightleftharpoons$  and  $N \approx 997$ \* from  $\rightleftharpoons$ 

### Psychological & political measures

- Future Anxiety\*
- **Authoritarian & Democratic Support**
- Ideological self-placement\*
  - Political participation\*

#### III. Main Results


- 1. (UK) Future Anxiety correlates\* with ...
- Higher support for democracy: 95% CI [.23, .35]
- Higher political participation: 95% CI [.15, .28]

But no association with ...

- Ideological self-placement: 95% CI [-.13, .01]
- Authoritarian support: 95% CI [-.05, .08]

\*Controlling for Gender, Age, Living standard, Education, Migration background

2. (UK & GR) Future anxiety correlates with more right-conservative ideology in young men but not women



#### IV. Conclusion & Future Directions

Anxiety about the future may encourage young people to engage with democratic values Future anxiety may be a key correlate of the growing ideological divide in youth

Focus on youth:

> Young generations affected by crises & potential to defend democratic values!
